Umpiring

We have received great feedback from teams about the club funded umpires this season which is good to hear! Umpiring is a tough gig, especially when we see things differently to players on the court and supporters on the sidelines - some of the comments directed at us can be pretty harsh. So with this in mind, we would like to remind you of your responsibilities as a player, coach or spectator in regards to conduct.

Accept the decision of the umpire regardless of your perspective, whether on court or sideline

Backchat to/about umpires is not acceptable.

Aggressive play is not acceptable

Poor sportsmanship is not acceptable

Umpires have the following tools within the rules to use should they see fit.

Actions that may be taken by Umpires – a structured approach to various occurrences of ‘unsportsmanlike conduct’:

- Penalise with a sanction
- Caution a player
- Issue an official warning to a player
- Suspend a player for 2 minutes
- Order a player off

Official warning, suspending a player, ordering off a player is considered to have been made jointly by the two umpires and is binding on the co-umpire

Put simply - umpires can, within the rules of Netball, remove you from the court for repeated instances of poor behaviour. Please don't make them do this - its not enjoyable for either party and reflects poorly on our club.


Remember - umpires are hard to find and important to keep. Please treat them with the respect they deserve.
